

YCS Summer Camp Mask Policy

After much consideration and careful review of the recently released CDC Summer Camp Guidelines, we are implementing the following mask policy at our summer camps:

- All participants should arrive at camp wearing a mask and have at least one additional mask available for use.
- Masks will be required for all participants (campers, staff and visitors) anytime they are indoors, except while eating or drinking, when they will be provided at least 6' of social distance. Masks will also be required for all participants while on a bus.
- Masks will not be worn when doing outdoor activities that could get masks wet, like using boats and watercraft, swimming, or other water activities.
- While outdoors, masks are optional unless the participants (campers, staff or visitors) are in an enclosed or partially enclosed area (e.g., a dugout) or standing still/seated fewer than 6' away from one another. Camp staff will direct campers as to when they may have the option to remove their masks.

YCS fully supports all who choose to continue wearing a mask during the times masks are deemed optional.

We will continue to monitor CDC guidelines and community transmission rates with the understanding that our mask policy may change as conditions and CDC recommendations evolve. Please feel free to email or call with questions or concerns.
