YCS Clipper Care Staff

The Town of Yarmouth, through Yarmouth Parks, Recreation & Community Services, is hiring part-time staff to work in the Chipper Care program.

Under the supervision of the Yarmouth Community Services Assistant Director, the After School Child Care Staff is responsible for assisting in the programming and supervision of the Clipper Care program various locations in Yarmouth during the 2020-2021 School Year. Clipper Care Staff will help plan and implement a program of activities for approximately 100 children in grades K-5, which will ensure each child's personal safety while providing social engagement, physical activities and learning experiences. The Clipper Care Staff will work closely with Yarmouth Community Services and the Yarmouth School District to ensure that all areas of the job responsibilities reflect the mission of Yarmouth Community Services.

Successful candidates should have some child care supervision experience.

- **Program Dates:** September 8, 2020 – Last Day of School (no program during school vacations, holidays, snow days and teacher in-service days). Training dates will be scheduled the week of August 31, 2020.
- **Work Hours:** Monday – Friday, part-time hours vary from 7:00am-6:30pm
- **Program Locations:** Yarmouth Elementary School, Rowe School, Harrison Middle School, and other locations, as needed.
- **Rate of Pay:** \$12 - \$25 / hour based on experience and positions available
- **Positions will be filled to work at the following programs:**
 - **Before School Care**, at school buildings if school is in-person learning, hours are approximately 7:00am-9:15am.
 - **After School Care**, at school buildings if school is in-person learning, hours are approximately 2:00pm-6:30pm
 - **Full-Day Options**, located at various locations if school is offering hybrid or remote learning, hours range from 4-8 per day, scheduled from 7:00am-6:30pm
