

## YCS Teen Camp Expectations

- ❖ All campers are responsible for their own conduct and will be expected to adhere to the Yarmouth Community Services Behavior Expectations (please see reverse). If there are any problems please inform a staff person, do not take on the responsibility yourself.
- ❖ The camp fee covers the admission to all events. It does not cover meals or souvenirs, extra rides or anything not covered in the group package.
- ❖ The schedule is subject to change due to rainouts and opportunities that are presented to us during the summer.
- ❖ Small groups will be made weekly for attendance purposes, this will normally be a few times per day. At most locations you may form your own groups with a minimum of 3 people.
- ❖ Campers will be expected to participate in all activities. One camper's lack of participation and cooperation will affect the whole group. If a camper's lack of participation affects an activity a parent meeting may be necessary. Some activities will interest some more than others, an activity you may not be interested in may be of great interest to another camper.
- ❖ Campers are responsible for providing their own lunch. Cooler bags are strongly recommended as we may be carrying our lunches of a distance at times. Absolutely NO GLASS BOTTLES. Please only bring water, juice or sport drinks to camp. Please do not bring soda. We also encourage parents to pack healthy lunches and snacks.
- ❖ Please let me know in advance if there is a specific day of camp you will not be attending.
- ❖ Do not bring boom box radios or hand held video games. MP3/CD Players and cell phone are permitted on the bus or during certain activities at the discretion of the teen camp counselors. YCS is not responsible of any lost or stolen items.
